**Enskilda Gymnasiet** is an elite school in the sense that our students want to do their best. They want to learn and make progress. This means that we have a study environment that promotes students' learning and motivate them to become high achievers. Our goal is that every student will get the grade VG, or higher.

**Enskilda gymnasiet** has a high level of education. With highly qualified and competent teachers, who teach both in junior high school and high school, we are able to help our students obtain grades that allow them to get in the best universities in the world.

We cooperate with Universities and colleges. Already in year three, our high school students take 7.5 credits in German at Stockholm University. Those students who are working on the topic of cosmic radiation attend lectures at the Royal Institute of technology, and those who choose the math course "Matematik cirkel" take the entire course there.

We prepare our students for studies as well as work abroad. Our students take courses in English at proficiency level. Furthermore, they are offered courses in modern languages such as French, Spanish and German at level 6 and 7. At the end of year 2, our students have the opportunity to enroll in courses in modern languages at level 5 in Munich (Germany), in Aix (France) or in Nerja (Spain).

We place great emphasis on culture and take advantage of our location in the heart of Sweden's capital city. Each semester, we expect our students to read several novels. We go regularly to the Royal dramatic theatre or the national theatre and to our own auditorium; we often invite authors, politicians and scholars to give lectures. In our quest to develop the whole person and to train the student's social competence and creativity, we offer courses in rhetoric, drama, art and design, photographic design, driving, solos and choral music.

**Enskilda Gymnasiet** is a school with good discipline and clear code of conduct. We take great pride in creating a study environment that makes it possible for our students to reach high goals. Every student at the school is expected to sign a contract agreeing to follow the school regulations.

Teaching time is important. At **Enskilda Gymnasiet**, we have high staffing ratio. We have teacher-led classes during the entire school day. Since our teaching time is important, we expect high attendance. We have extended schedule in Swedish, English and mathematics, and in order to ensure that each student is getting the help needed in English and in mathematics; they are divided into different groups according to their level.

We show mutual respect and do our utmost to prevent and combat bullying. Because we are a relatively small school, teachers and school management have the opportunity to get to know each student individually. This creates safety and allows us to respond as early as possible if any problem arises.

We make sure that new students are well taken care of. Year 6 (junior high) and year 1 (high school) have their school start two days earlier in order for them to get acquainted with the school premises, their mentors and their classmates. In each class, there are two peers and at the end of each school year, one student is appointed "best schoolmate".

**Enskilda Gymnasiet** is a long-established free school with great commitment. The school was founded in 1913 and is owned and operated by parents through **Enskilda Gymnasiet Association**. Together with active parents, who share our vision of learning and discipline, we will better achieve our goal.
